FOREST INDUSTRY ENGINEERING ASSOCIATION (FIEA) SCHOLARSHIP

BACKGROUND:

The Forest Industry Engineering Association (FIEA), a division of Innovatek Ltd, is a unique grouping in Australasia. It's the principal vehicle for technology transfer for forestry and wood products companies. Through a range of independent programmes, new product and process technologies are introduced to New Zealand and Australian companies.

A regular series of conferences, practical workshops and managed exhibitions are run every year. Forestry and wood products companies, key product suppliers, researchers and technology providers from throughout the world are targeted and involved with the programmes. FIEA is also now the largest provider of weekly and monthly forest products news in Australasia.

As a commitment to the New Zealand forest products industry, FIEA, through its Educational Fund has supported an upgrade of the Waiariki Institute of Technology's National Training Centre in Rotorua and made a significant contribution to the purchase of modern saw doctoring equipment as part of a redesign of the New Zealand trade qualification.

This FIEA Scholarship has also been set up to encourage and support an outstanding student in their third year of study who is undertaking either a Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) Forest Engineering, or Bachelor of Forestry Science and who has a strong interest in Wood Science or Engineering.

SCHOLARSHIP VALUE:

The total scholarship payable to any one student shall be of a cash value of **\$2,500** incl GST.

NOTES:

1. The scholarship shall be known as the FIEA Scholarship.
2. The award shall be made to students who:
 - (a) Are enrolled in the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) Forest Engineering, or Bachelor of Forestry Science and have a strong interest in Wood Science.
 - (b) Students completing their 3rd Year of study and going to Year 4
3. Award of the scholarship shall be granted on the recommendation of a Selection Committee approved by the Forest Engineering Association.
4. The Selection Committee shall shortlist applicants for the scholarship, may conduct interviews with those applicants short-listed, and apply the following selection criteria:
 - (a) Academic achievement in Forest Engineering and Wood Science (i.e. FORE 205 and FORE/ENFO 327)
 - (b) Other factors considered relevant
5. The Forest Industry Engineering Association at its sole discretion may refrain from making an award.
6. The scholarship may be held with any other bursary, scholarship, prize or tertiary allowance unless the conditions of the other awards provide otherwise.

7. Up to one scholarship may be awarded each year by the Forest Industry Engineering Association. A total of five Scholarships from 2012 through to 2017 may be awarded.
8. The scholarship monies will be paid directly into the scholarship recipient's account on the awarding of the scholarship.
9. Application for the scholarship is to be made on the application form and forwarded to the Director, Forest Industry Engineering Association **no later than 1 March 2012.**

ADVICE TO APPLICANTS:

Applications must arrive by the closing date shown on the form. No undertaking is given to accept late applications.

Please note that only materials requested on the Application Form and/or in the Regulations are to be submitted - e.g. do not attach a C.V. unless you are requested to do so. Any additional material will be removed from your application in the interests of equity. Material submitted cannot be returned.
